Fire Safety Inspector

This course is designed to meet the requirements for Fire Safety Inspector as prescribed by the Ohio Administrative Code 4765-20-03 "Qualifications for a Fire Safety Inspector Certificate" through the Ohio Department of Public Safety and NFPA 1031. Participants will gain an understanding of the Fire Inspector's role in Code Enforcement, general fire prevention practices, fire safety requirements related to hazardous materials, electrical systems, and fire protection systems. Students are required to attend all classes and pass both written and practical exams to successfully complete the course. For certification, students must pass the Division of EMS Fire Safety Inspector exam. This course will be offered as a hybrid course, with online and distance learning, as approved by the state of Ohio Division of EMS.

Grain Bin Rescue Awareness / Operations

We will cover the tools and resources necessary for when an entrapment call comes in. Students will know the differences from rescue vs. recovery, as well as, a good “lock out tag out” procedure. The course will cover the “basic” knowledge needed to help assist a trained rescue company or team in the rescue operations on scene.

Grain Bin Rescue Operations / Technician

We will create and review the immediate action steps when notified of an emergency – “Hazard Assessment Processing”. Individuals will become more familiar with the use of necessary equipment needed when on a call. Students will learn the proper “360 size-up”, calling for the necessary resources, how to supervise, lead, and plan a strategic rescue. We will discuss more in depth the operational direction under which emergencies at grain storage and handling facilities should be responded to.

Live Fire Operations With JPR's Skill Day

NFPA 1403, *Standard on Live Fire Training Evolutions* involves specific requirements for prerequisite training, evolution planning, development, implementation, supervision & management oversight, monitoring and records management of live fire training evolutions in acquired structures, training center burn buildings and exterior fire evolutions of a variety of types. The course includes an in-depth analysis of NFPA 1403; addressing evolutions at acquired structures, gas-fired training buildings, non-gas-fired training buildings, and exterior props, vehicle fires and exterior class B fires. The combination of classroom and practical activities allows participants to apply the knowledge of the applicable standards to live fire training activities. Successful course completion fulfills the live fire training course requirement for fire instructors and assistant fire instructors as set forth in the Ohio Administrative Code.

The Ohio Department of Public Safety requires fire charters and EMS accreditations have a pre-knowledge entrance exam policy for fire and EMS courses. The WCRTF uses the ACT Workkeys exam to meet this requirement. All students at the WCRTF must take this ACT Workkeys Exam prior to taking any fire or EMS courses unless one of the following exemptions have been met; 1.) student has a college degree at any level, 2.) Student already possesses an ODPS fire or EMS certification at any level.
