Students (if not already) will also become certified as American Heart Association Health Care Provider for CPR/AED and First Aid.

# Grain Bin Rescue Awareness / Operations

This course is designed for the safety / awareness and brief introduction to the operations level(s) of a grain bin rescue for first responders. The course is designed to help students familiarize themselves with grain bins, the differences from an agriculture “silo”, their parts, construction, and hazards associated both in farm and industrial settings. We will cover the tools and resources necessary for when an entrapment call comes in. Students will know the differences between rescue vs. recovery, as well as a good “lock out tag out” procedure. The course will cover the “basic” knowledge needed to help assist a trained rescue company or team in the rescue operations on scene.

**Disclaimer:**

Every emergency situation has a life of its own. No two are exactly the same. Each involves different settings, different environmental conditions, different victims, and different combinations of emergency response capabilities. Consider the definition of an “emergency” – “an unforeseen combination of circumstances or the resulting state that calls for immediate action” (Webster, 10<sup>th</sup> ed). No one or two day class is capable of preparing first responders to effectively address every situation that may occur in the field on a family farm or grain storage / handling facility. Some circumstances will be unforeseen – there may be multiple circumstances that will be seen and many may need immediate action. The purpose of our classes is not to provide comprehensive instruction for all or even the most frequent emergencies that occur – but rather to present basic response tactics and strategies with the intent of reducing the risk for those responding and improving the probability of a successful rescue.

## Grain Bin Rescue Operations / Technician

This course is designed for the first responders to build off of knowledge and hands-on learned in the awareness / operations course to hone and utilize their skills and enter / perform a rescue in the grain bin. We will create and review the immediate action steps when notified of an emergency – “Hazard Assessment Processing”. Individuals will become more familiar with the use of necessary equipment needed when on a call. Students will learn the proper “360 size-up”, calling for the necessary resources, how to supervise, lead, and plan a strategic rescue. We will discuss more in depth the operational direction under which emergencies at grain storage and handling facilities should be responded to.

# ACT WorkKeys Exam



The Ohio Department of Public Safety requires fire charters and EMS accreditations have a pre-knowledge entrance exam policy for fire and EMS courses. The WCRTF uses the ACT Workkeys exam to meet this requirement. All students at the WCRTF must take this ACT Workkeys Exam prior to taking any fire or EMS courses unless one of the following exemptions has been met; 1.) student has a college degree at any level, 2.) Student already possesses an ODPS fire or EMS certification at any level.
